## 1. Characteristics

- Remotely controllable device from anywhere through the app
- Energy-saving: program different on/off schedules
- For indoor use
- Power LED indicator
- No HUB required
- Multi-user
- Compatible with Google Assistant and/or Amazon Alexa
- Compatible with Siri Shortcuts through routines created from the app
- Turn on and off manually, from the app or by voice commands
- Allows you to create routines that trigger actions on other Lloyd's smart products

## 2. Before getting started



Make sure your smartphone has iOS 11.0 or higher or Android™ 5.0 or higher. Check your network and make sure you are connected to a 2.4 GHz Wi Fi channel.

Download the Lloyds Smart app from App Store or on Google Play or scan the following QR code with your smartphone.





## 3. Registration and access

Open the Lloyds Smart app. To register, click on "Sign up" (1), to continue click "Agree", choose your country and enter an email address, then click on "Get Verification Code"(2).




Enter the code sent to your email (check inbox or spam) (3), set a password, and click "Done" (4). Or log in directly if you already have an account.






#### 4. Add device

Start the Lloyds Smart app on your smartphone, select "+" (upper right corner) (1), choose the type of device that you want to add. In this case, go to "Energy" (2), then click on "Socket" (3).




Enter your Wi Fi network information and password, click "Next" (4). Connect the plug to the power supply, then press and hold the power button for 5 seconds, until you notice that the blue LED flashes rapidly. Confirm in the app (5), then click "Next" (6).




Once the device is configured, you can change the name (7) and finally click "Done" (8)

**Note:**


Make sure the Wi Fi password you enter is correct and the device is close to the modem during the process.



After configuration, find and select the device in the list (9) to be able to control it through the app from wherever you are, only internet connection is required.



## 5. Device control



1. More functions
2. Turn on / off the device
3. On / Off scheduling
4. On / Off timer

In “**More functions**” (interface upper right corner), you will be able to rename the device, share control of it with family and acquaintances, access information, create groups, update the firmware or delete the device.

**Note:**

The name that you assign to the device will be the one that you use with your Alexa or Google Assistant-enabled device for voice control.

## 6. How to configure with Siri Shortcuts

The Lloyd’s smart products are compatible with Siri Shortcuts through routines created from the app. For configuration details, scan the following QR code with your smartphone:

Make sure your smartphone has iOS 12 or higher.



## 7. Google Assistant and Amazon Alexa

### How to connect to Google Assistant:

1. Download and open the Google Home app, previously configured with your Gmail account and your Google Assistant-enabled device.
2. Click on the "+" icon, choose "Set up Device," then in the "Works with Google" section, click on the search bar and type in Lloyds Smart. When you get the icon, click on it. Enter your Lloyds Smart account and click on "Link now". Then press on "Authorize" and wait a few seconds.
3. Once you have linked Lloyds Smart, the devices added to your account will be displayed, click on "X" (top left corner) and return to the main screen. Now you can control your Lloyd's Smart devices using just your voice with Google.

#### Note:

You can rename the devices from the Lloyds Smart app to control them with voice commands. Every time you rename the devices, say: "Hey Google, sync devices" or update from the Google Home app.

Try saying "Hey Google" followed by one of the following commands:



**"Hey Google, turn on the coffee maker"**

**"Hey Google, turn off the lights"**

### How to connect to Amazon Alexa:

1. Download and access the "Amazon Alexa" app, previously configured with your email account and your virtual assistant.
2. Click on the option "Skills & games", then in the search bar type Lloyds Smart. When you get the icon, click on it. Then press the "Activate to use" button.

3. Enter your Lloyds Smart account and click on "Link Now" and finally "Authorize". You will get the message "Linked successfully", click on "Close" and wait a few seconds.
4. Click "Detect devices" to find the smart devices. Now you can ask your assistant to control them by voice commands.

**Note:**

You can rename the devices from the Lloyds Smart app to control them with voice commands. Every time you rename the devices, say: "Alexa, sync devices" or update from the Amazon Alexa app.

Voice command examples:



**"Alexa, Turn on the coffee maker."**

**"Alexa, Turn off the lights."**

**Note:**

The Google Home and Amazon Alexa apps are constantly being updated. For more information, please refer to their user manuals.
